I'll start on the library homepage.

Click the Research menu item, then select Subject Guides.

On the Subject Guides page, select Anthropology.

My contact information is listed on the left-hand side of the page.

If you have a quick question, feel free to e-mail me.

I aim to respond to emails within one business day.

If you have a more in-depth question about one of your assignments and you need some help with your research, just use the link at the left side of the page to book an appointment with me.

This connects to my work calendar and shows all my availabilities.

Feel free to select a time that's good for you.

If you can let me know what course your question relates to, and any information about your topic, that will be helpful.

And this is the **second thing** I want to briefly mention to you.

On this page we have listed the most relevant databases available to you that you can use to find high quality, scholarly research in Anthropology.

Often your professors will ask you to use peer-reviewed articles specifically from the Anthropological literature.
