

Connecting to Library Resources Using Google Scholar

When using Google Scholar it can be time consuming to locate copies of the articles and books you find.

Luckily there's a way to connect to resources at the Laurier Library in Google Scholar. Here's how to do it.

First, go to Google Scholar and sign in with either your Google account or your @mylaurier.ca email.

Next, click on the Menu icon at the top left.

Choose Settings from the menu that appears.

Then choose Library Links from the tab options across the top.

Search for Wilfrid Laurier in the search box.

Check the boxes next to the Wilfrid Laurier options that appear to select them.

Then click Save.

Now when you search Google Scholar, GetIt@Laurier links appear next to the items in your search results if the Library has access to the resource.

If you click GetIt@Laurier, you will go to the item record in the Omni Library catalogue or other Library databases.

Here you will see options to see the full text.
